

Libro Centre – AMHA ‘Return to Hockey’ Access Procedures

1. A COVID Questionnaire will be posted on the AMHA website and needs to be completed prior to arriving at the Libro Centre. COVID Check-In to be completed at the Main Entrance (between double-doors). All entrants to the Libro Centre are required to wear a mask or face-covering. Players to enter Libro Centre wearing ALL equipment except helmets, gloves, and skates. Players to wear masks/face-coverings until placing helmet on in dressing room, or as they take the ice. **ONE** parent/guardian to enter with each player. Coaching staff is excluded from this count, as coaches are required to remain on the ice with the team, should an issue arise.



2. Doors to the Libro Centre only open 15 minutes prior to designated ice time. These doors will remain open for **ONLY** 15 minutes. Anyone entering the arena needs to be in the rink before the teams take the ice. Doors will be closed once the team(s) takes the ice, prohibiting any further entry. **NO FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED INTO THE LIBRO CENTRE.** (Water bottles for on-ice activities and use **ONLY**)



- 3. Entrants to be separated from other user groups and are asked to maintain social distancing. Mezzanine (upstairs viewing) is closed and not accessible to anyone.



- 4. "Skate Tying" area setup to allow parents to assist players with tying skates.



5. Seats/locations setup to allow social distancing. Divisions U8 and younger will not have access to dressing rooms, and will use these areas for skate tying, and putting on helmets and gloves.



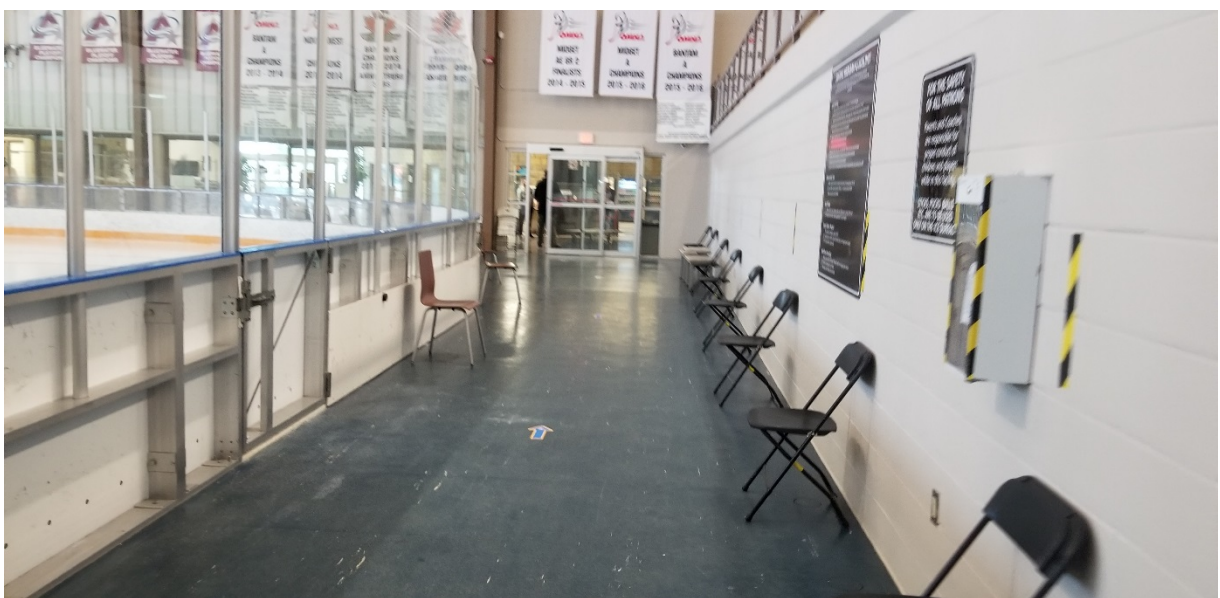
6. Dressing rooms and access to the ice surface will be through the Main Dressing Room Hallway.



7. Social distancing will be maintained in the dressing rooms. REMINDER: Masks/face coverings to be worn until helmets are put on, and players are ready to take the ice. Players will remain in dressing room until ice surface is cleaned, and the previous teams have left the dressing rooms and areas. Dressing rooms will be accessible to ages U9 and older.



8. Skate removal stations have been setup for younger players (U8 and younger) who need assistance removing their skates. All other players will remove skates, helmets, and gloves in dressing rooms, and leave the rink as quickly as possible.



- Parents are only permitted to enter ice rink doors when players have left the ice to assist with skate removal, or in an **emergency** (ie: your child needs your assistance, either using washroom during ice time, or due to injury). Coaches will assist in getting your attention from the Viewing Area.



- All parents/spectators are to remain in the assigned Viewing Area, while maintaining social distancing. Stickers have been placed at 6 foot spacing to assist in maintain social distancing. Amherstburg By-Laws will be strictly enforced. **REMINDER:** No outside food or drink permitted.



- Once the players leave the ice, all parents/spectators and players have only 10 minutes to exit the building.
